Financial Update

- Expenses exceeding income, only raised dues once in recent history. Propose to raise annual dues by \$5 to \$40; that would help offset expenses and keep us from spending down reserves. Offset increased utility costs, etc Only way to approve increase is at the annual meeting,

- Last Friday- bad accident at corner of Gainsborough and Tuckerman- entranceway is pretty badly damaged
 - Claim filed with driver through Geico on behalf of neighborhood for repairs, repair underway but could be slow process

- neighbor suggestion: would be a good spot for red light camera. Board doesn't know anything about how you go about getting one; a few neighbors will go on county website and make calls to see who to contact. Part of that intersection will be redone with the project on sidewalks and bike lanes- could submit comments via that project. Website shared in chat. Appears it may already be on the horizon with the county as part of that project.
- Couple years ago talk of putting cell phone or WiFi receptors on street lights in neighborhoods- any update?
 - letters sent by Verizon about 5G receptors on lampposts- maybe 2-3 years ago or possibly pre-pandemic, no other knowledge of it
- Cherry blossoms looking sad - have about a 60-year life span, getting close to end of life. Have branches falling, county should trim them. Won't cut them down unless at end of life. Contact 311, website was also shared. County will replace them but it's a long wait
- Neighbors fence at Lamplighter was too close to neighborhood entrance - was inspected by county and fence was moved - now entirely on their own property
- We welcome new board members anytime- please reach out
- Current board agreed to stay on in same capacities for 2024-2025. Approved
